

Taken from the MET Charter

Article 2

The aims proposed for the new Association, none of which are commercial in nature, are as follows:

1. To maintain a stable network and means of encounter for language consultants who provide support in regard to various aspects of communication by contributing to the production of both oral and written texts for international dissemination (mainly in the English language although this focus may shift according to local demand over time), and who work with any type of text produced by knowledge societies or institutions in carrying out activities that require linguistic support for outreach and expression.
2. To communicate knowledge that contributes to improving the quality of language support services offered in the Mediterranean region.
3. To act as a channel for establishing contact and exchanging information between language consultants in the Mediterranean area and those in other parts of Europe and the world.
4. To foster research into changes in the use of language in international communication, the needs of different groups, and good practices in language consultancy, and to seek solutions that enhance the international outreach and expression of professional and intellectual endeavours in academic, scientific, political and other fields of relevance in the Mediterranean region.
5. To identify existing expertise and good practices within the Association's sphere of action and to foster exchanges between experts, within Europe and worldwide, by means of conferences and professional publications.
6. To assist users of language support services to locate appropriate solutions that meet their needs and, in general, to promote mutual understanding between suppliers and users of language services.
